

## UCLA Department of Classics Bylaws

### I. *Membership*

For the purposes of these bylaws, the categories of Department faculty are defined as follows:

**Core faculty** comprises all ladder faculty with departmental appointments, including split appointments of 50% time or more in Classics. This designation does not include lecturers, adjunct, or visiting faculty.

**Emeritae/i faculty** comprises all former core faculty.

### II. *Voting Privileges*

1. All core faculty are entitled to vote on all personnel actions and on any other departmental matters. Any core faculty member may request a reconsideration of this provision, which will be addressed according to the procedures outlined in Title VI, §55, part B. of the UC Academic Senate Bylaws.

2. Emeritae/i faculty may participate in departmental discussions, but do not have voting privileges (except as in 3. below).

3. Voting privileges on non-personnel matters may be extended to Emeritae/i upon a majority vote by secret ballot of the core faculty, and on personnel matters by at least a two-thirds majority vote by secret ballot of the core faculty. Any such extension of privilege to Emeritae/i must remain in effect for at least one calendar year; thereafter, any core faculty member may request reconsideration.
